

Penny Mullen Poster Prize

In 2009 the MASCIP Poster Prize was renamed in memory of our late MASCIP Secretary Penny Mullen. The Penny Mullen Poster Prizes will be awarded for the best poster presented at the Annual Conference as voted by the MASCIP Scientific Committee and the Conference delegates. Posters need not be restricted to the theme of the conference but should represent one or more of the following:

- Original research
- Audit (preference given where audit cycle has been completed)
- Service developments
- Examples of good practice
- Case reports with clear, interesting learning point

The MASCIP Scientific Committee and Conference delegates will judge the posters during the conference and a prize will be awarded for the winning entry. The prize will be awarded during the afternoon proceedings.

Poster abstracts are included in the delegate packs. Typed abstracts (max 300 words) should be emailed to mascipsecretary@hotmail.co.uk 6 weeks before the Conference. E-mail confirmation of acceptance of poster abstracts will be given 4 weeks before the Conference.
